## ROLES \& RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teachers:

- Sets the work ensuring it is age and ability appropriate
- Monitors, marks \& gives feedback.


## Teacher aides:

- Assist with monitoring \& marking completed work.
- $\quad$ Support learning needs \& give feedback.


## Parents

- Monitor work at home.
- Support their child's ability to complete tasks.
- Maintains communication with class eacher
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## Students:

- Work within a productive timeframe.
- Complete tasks to the best of their ability.
- Ask for help when needed in a timely manner.


## What does homework look like for students at Airville?

- Below is an example of the usual weekly routine.
- Completed work is handed in at the beginning of each day for daily monitoring marking, feedback and specific, individual support if it is required.
- Students who do not/ cannot complete their homework at home are provided with time \& support prior to school and at other negotiated times to complete their tasks.
