## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in Mathematics to 90% or better for students in Years 1 – 6 in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English to 90% or better for students in Years 1 – 6 in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of Prep students able to read and comprehend short, predictable texts and compose and record short, meaningful sentences to 100% at the reporting level of 'Working With' or better.

## Our initiatives include:

- Monitoring early phase literacy and numeracy for intervention and/or extension utilising the schedule of Early Start assessments.
- Providing scheduled opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention or extension utilising age appropriate pedagogies and higher order thinking skills.
- Extending the shared understanding of 'data literacy' through the use of the literacy continuums P-2 and 3-6 and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use this data to inform targeted teaching, learning and differentiation.
- Extending teacher capabilities in embedding processes for meaningful feedback to students within each teaching and learning cycle.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Upskilling all teachers to use OneSchool's functionalities such as Dashboard, developmental maps, literacy continuums, mark book, Individual Curriculum Plans, differentiation placemat etc to inform targeted, individualised teaching and learning and monitoring of student improvements.	\$0
